



## MATHEMATICS

### Key Stage 3

In KS3 students are set according to ability. Pupils begin to build on knowledge gained in primary school and start to refine and deepen their mathematical skills, ready to embark on their GCSE when they enter Yr10. All years follow the same learning journey at different levels which takes them through the key areas of Shape, Space and Measure; Number; Algebra and Data handling.

Students also develop their numeracy skills in a fortnightly Numeracy lesson which focuses on everything from basic number skills to problem solving, to start preparing them for their Numeracy GCSE. In the summer, each pupil sits the National Numeracy Tests in designed by the Welsh Government to help assess their progress year on year.
